



The Swan Treasure Hunt

Welcome to our Treasure Hunt – and good luck.

The questions below are set in the order you should reach them – there are no trick questions. So let's get started!!!

Turn left out of the Swan and the first question is close by.

Q1: What is the telephone number to the left of a white M in a red circle?

Now cross over and continue down

Q2: When did George get better?

Q3: What is above the information point?

A quick detour to the left, to the shop window full of nursery rhymes

Q4: How many soldiers are there in the window?

Back to Main St, and a further question before the Memorial Hall.

Q5: Who were established in 1959?

From the Memorial Hall, you continue your journey by travelling past a High Manor and beyond

Q6: What rank was Thomas Perkins?

Q7: What time is the collection made at Leeds Mail Centre, Leodis House, Leeds way, Stourton?

Q8: What number bus travels between Ilkley – Malham, and when?

Got the hang of it now? Well, don't forget to turn left at the white telephone

Q9: What does 0800 7-3-8-3-7-7-3 mean?

Having passed Tom's Garth, you will need to turn to the right as you reach the end of the road in order to avoid the parish councillors.

Q10: This couple presented a board to celebrate their golden anniversary. Who are they?

Q11: As you continue, can you tell me what Hannah at number 35 had?

You should be passing another orchard now – this really is quite easy isn't it? So far anyway.

Q12: What kind of apricots are in the garden?

Time to turn left at the new wall opposite Cornerstones, and then left through the gate, and down the steps. Cross the bridge and follow the path, with one slight detour

Q13: As you cross the bridge, whose memory is the bench in front of you dedicated to?

Enjoy your grassy stroll. At the end, go to the right-hand side of the large rock and (very) small hedge, over another bridge, and turn right when you reach the road

Q14: 'A visible guiding point or device'. What street am I referring to?



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Q15: '.....St,Lane?

Before a brief respite, one further question

Q16: What is the oldest date on this map?

Now just follow the signs for the Dales Way and enjoy the scenery for while. No more questions until you reach the car park. And then,

Q17: What field have you just been through?

Follow the road now, up the hill, and past the paddocks

Q18: What is the significance of 1812?

Turn left, and pass the schoolchildren. Carry straight on – you would be barking not to. Turn right after you pass two benches close together.

Q19: How many round holes can you see as you walk over the bridge?

Q20: The next bridge has a maximum height – what is it?

Q21: what number follows a ski?

Carry straight on up the lane

Q22: What numbers form the complete H?

Q23: When was the Chapel enlarged?

Q24: What is the name of the terrace on the left opposite the church?

Turn right after the notice board if you want to improve your education

Q25: What do numbers 1-13 have a good view of?

Turn left at the place where the hen was injured, follow the road to the end, and walk through the gap in the wall into Main Street

Q26: What is the number on the lamp post facing you?

Head downhill now, you are on the home straight

Q27: Carlsberg and what other beer appear side by side?

Q28: What number is Beckside Cottage?

Q29: What are collectable at 01943 830095?

Q30: CJM 17 748 – which textile manufacturers lived here?

And so back to the Swan for a well deserved rest and recuperation
